Successful education is founded upon a strong partnership between the academy, students and parents. The Sir Geoffrey Leigh Academy is committed to raising and maintaining high standards in work, behaviour and attitude. In return, all students accepted by The Sir Geoffrey Leigh Academy, supported by their parents, are expected to to meet the standards required and to observe the standards, expectations and routines of the academy.

THE SIR GEOFFREY LEIGH ACADEMY agrees to provide for every student:

- a broad, balanced education, maximising potential and encouraging high aspirations
- work which is appropriate to each child's age and ability
- enrichment and extra-curricular activities
- a secure and well-disciplined environment (students in years 7 − 11 are not allowed off site during the school day)
- homework opportunities
- reports and review twice each academic year
- at least one parents' consultation meeting each year
- information about progress, and prompt consultation, to discuss any difficulties which may arise

As a SIR GEOFFREY LEIGH ACADEMY Student: I agree to:

- ensure I show respect to academy staff at all times.
- ensure I take responsibility for my learning and my behaviour.
- ensure I push myself to be a resilient learner.
- ensure I am developing my understanding of the various IB Learner Profiles
- show respect for The Sir Geoffrey Leigh Academy environment and property
- remain at The Sir Geoffrey Leigh Academy, or in full-time education or training, until I am 18 if I meet the criteria
- attend the academy regularly and strive for exemplary attendance
- be punctual at all times, arriving by 8:20am
- remain on the academy site during academy hours
- work hard and meet all course requirements
- complete homework tasks on time
- wear the full and correct academy uniform
- bring a well-stocked pencil case, a calculator, a dictionary and a fully charged Chromebook along with any other equipment needed at all times
- meet The Sir Geoffrey Leigh Academy standards and expectations and conduct myself in a responsible way, both in the academy and when travelling to and from the academy
- not bring in any tobacco, vape pens, alcohol, illegal drugs or offensive weapons as this will jeopardise my place see the behaviour code for more information
- not maliciously interfere with academy equipment, including fire equipment and the fire alarm as this will jeopardise my place

As Parent(s)/Carer(s) I/We agree to:

- ensure both myself and my child show respect to academy staff at all times.
- ensure I allow my child to take responsibility for their actions.
- ensure I support my child to become a more resilient individual.
- support and work with the academy to encourage a positive attitude to education
- ensure I am supporting my child to develop their understanding of the various IB Learner Profiles
- ensure excellent attendance and punctuality and inform the academy each day of any absence.
- avoid family holidays during academy term-time

N.B. The Governors do not approve holidays during term-time

- make time to talk and listen to my child, discuss homework, when appropriate, and give positive support
 to efforts and progress my child has made
- attend parents' meetings and academy functions, in which my child is involved, and any special appointments, as requested
- let the academy know if there are any factors which may affect my child's performance
- support the academy's Behaviour For Learning policy, including sanctions such as after-school detentions.
- keep my child in correct uniform at all times, including regulation shoes and PE kit
- provide him/her with a well-stocked pencil case, a calculator, a dictionary and a fully charged Chromebook along with any other equipment needed at all times
- pay for the replacement of any damaged, or lost books, or equipment
- pay for the repair of any damage caused by my child
- support my child in full-time education or training to 18
- support the values of respect and understanding promoted by the academy
- support the academy policy on maliciously interfering with academy equipment, including fire equipment and the fire alarm
